

The East Bay Area. More to explore.

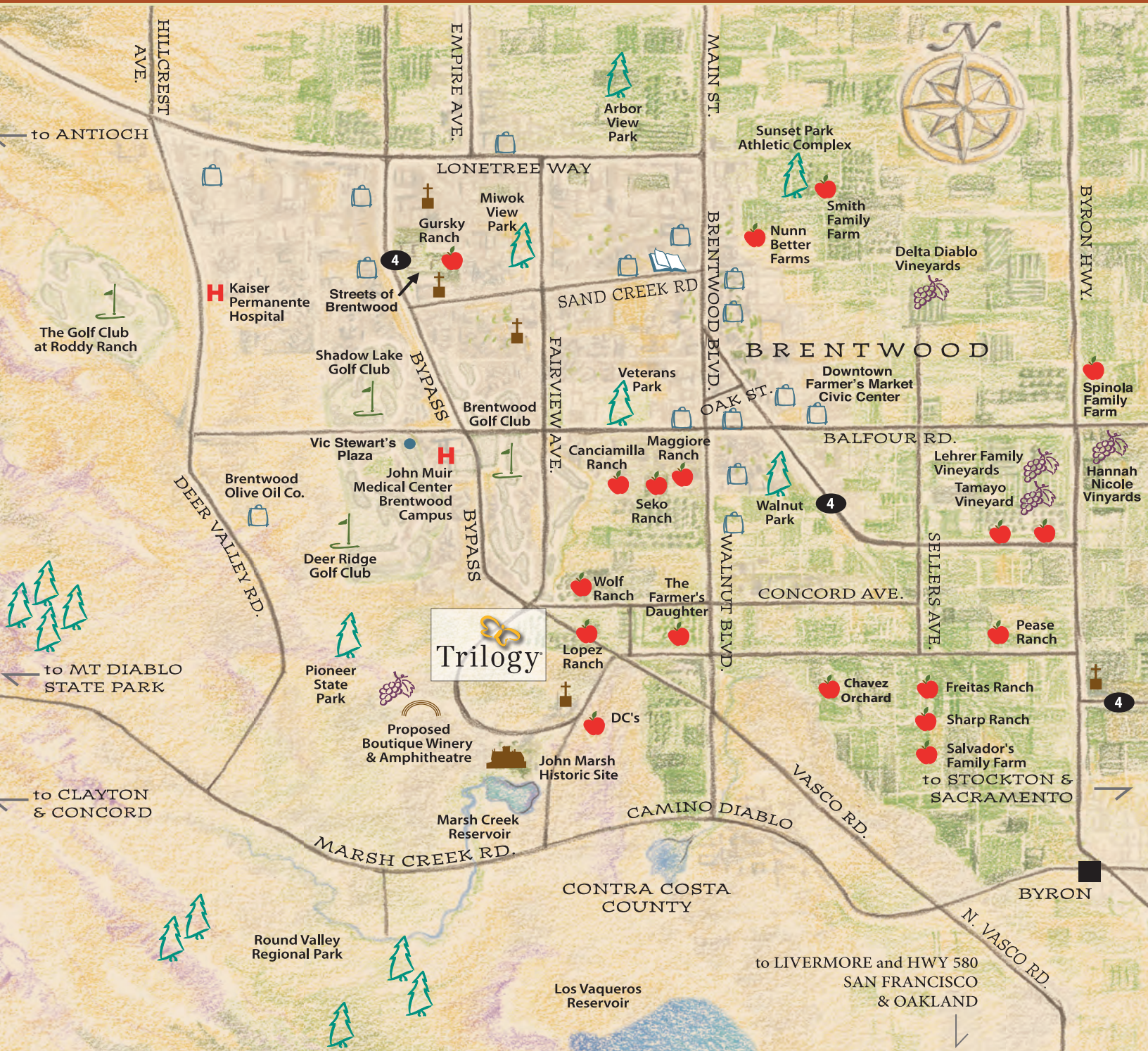
